Our School

The Morinville Learning Centre is an outreach school. We provide an alternative high school setting that offers an opportunity for students to earn high school credits using a flexible, individualized approach. Students can attend the Learning Centre on a full-time or part-time basis. Students may access the centre to complete an extra course or repeat a course if necessary. The Learning Centre provides students flexibility so they can take a course even if they are registered at another high school.

Our school environment focuses on supportive teacher-learner relationships. We provide students the opportunity to learn at a pace that is appropriate for them. Students can take advantage of various learning methods including personalized face-to-face instruction and offsite learning. Our teachers provide feedback and support through learning plans developed for specific student needs.

In addition to regular daytime hours, our teachers offer learning support late Wednesday evenings from noon to 8:00pm. We also run summer school programs each July. This flexibility allows students to fit their education around a variety of responsibilities such as work, family, sport commitments and other school programs. We also support families who desire home schooling alternatives.
