All about LOGOS

- LOGOS means "the Word of God" and is an interdenominational Christian program centred on God's Word, which is the Bible, and God's Son, our Savior Jesus Christ
- Offered to students from kindergarten to grade 4 at Landing Trail School in Gibbons, and grades 5 to 9 at Lilian Schick School in Bon Accord
- Part of Sturgeon School Division's unique programming, and open to all students

A strong educational focus

- LOGOS is part of the public school system and teaches the Alberta curriculum
- Children remain involved in school-wide events, programs and other activities
- Students learn the same subject matter as others in the school system, but most courses are taught with a Christian viewpoint

A Christian-based perspective

- LOGOS is a non-denominational Christian-based program offered in a nurturing setting, where children are taught to love God and others
- The Christian environment is enhanced through daily activities (prayer, scripture reading, praise), periodic chapel times and assemblies that build faith, celebrate Christian holidays and bring the LOGOS community together for fellowship
- Supports the spiritual values parents teach at home, ensuring each child's faith is nurtured, reinforced and sustained at school
