2022/2023 Budget Process

As part of the annual budget process, the Board of Trustees must review the following fees and make decisions:

- Complementary Learning Resources Fees
- Non-Funded Student Fee Schedule
- Transportation Fees

By majority vote, the Board of Trustees made the following decisions regarding fees:

<u>Complementary Learning Resources</u> (CLR) Fees

CLR fees eliminated from Sturgeon Public moving forward.

Non-Funded Student Fee Schedule

Fee schedule accepted as presented.

Transportation Fees

15% increase for all student riders.



Learning Supports and First Nation, Métis, and Inuit Success

Public assurance occurs when all students belong and learn in environments that support their needs. Public confidence is built when system resources are used to ensure optimum learning for all.

Sturgeon Public Schools foster a welcoming learning environment and implement support for physical, social, mental, and emotional wellness in students.

Our schools have implemented and improved strategic plans to ensure understanding of Indigenous perspectives and knowledge by:

- providing classroom resources and support
 - Grade 2 & 6 Indigenous books and resources to support leveled reading and guided reading.
 - Grade 2 Mathematics lessons and material written by Indigenous authors to provide authentic perspectives.

- Whole school resources and support:
 - Métis experience kits with lessons for teaching and students to experience.
 - Rebuilt Blanket Exercise kits to engage students in better understanding the Truth of Indigenous history in Canada.

First Nation, Métis, and Inuit students achieve and succeed as part of a community committed to understanding foundational Indigenous perspectives and knowledge.
