

# **Parent Engagement - Summary: We Are Listening!**



## 440 parents and 2 community members answered the survey.




#### **Dimensions with the Greatest Agreement**










### **Dimensions with the Greatest Disagreement**

The dimension of the survey with the greatest number of respondents who strongly disagreed or somewhat disagreed was, "the support and resources available at my child's school meet the diverse needs of all students" (23.6%).
