


Parent Engagement: We Are Listening!

440 parents and 2 community members answered the survey.




"The teachers at our school are caring, compassionate and dedicated to their students' success. The teachers do their best with what resources they are given."



Sturgeon Public Schools asked Parents or Guardians to indicate their level of agreement with each of the following statements:


I am satisfied with the quality of education that my child is receiving. 442 responses








I am satisfied with the available choice of courses and programs at my child's school. 442 responses









My child's learning needs are being met at school.










The school is helping my child become a good, caring citizen.









I am satisfied with the school's provision of activities that promote volunteerism and community service for students.

When asked, what Sturgeon Public Schools is doing well the following top themes emerged:


- Teachers and staff were acknowledged continuously for their care and dedication towards students.

When asked, **what Sturgeon Public Schools could improve upon** the following themes emerged:


- Dealing with safety issues related to student behavior and discipline.

- More workshops or learning opportunities for Parents would be appreciated.
